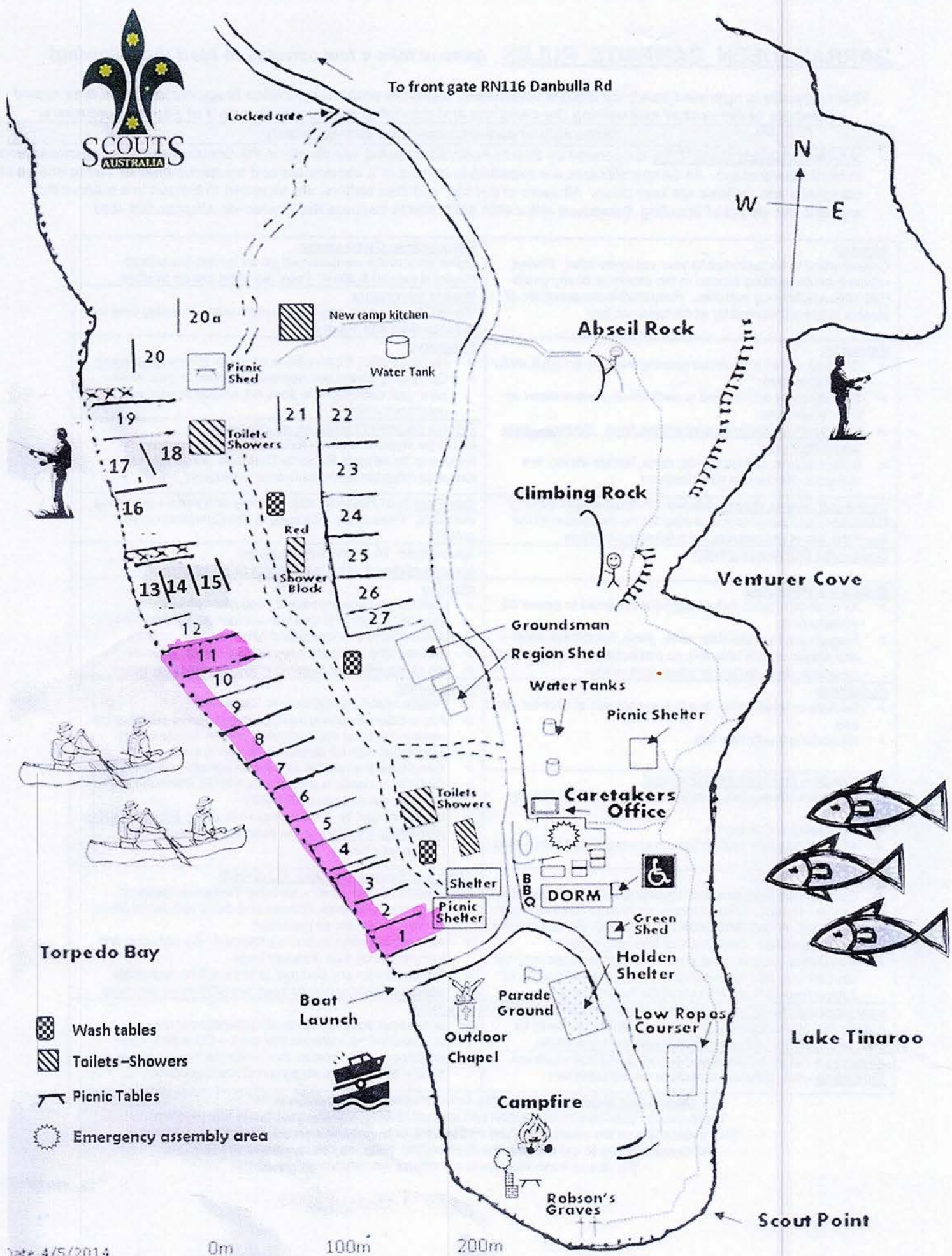


# CAMP BARRABADEEN

## **BARRABADEEN CAMPSITE RULES** (please take a few minutes to read the following)

*This campsite is operated solely by unpaid volunteers, therefore your co-operation is appreciated. All fees raised contribute to the cost of maintaining the campsite and providing for the development of all youth members.*

**Office Hours: 8am-11.30am then 4pm-6pm daily**

- > **BARRABADEEN CAMPSITE** is operated by Scouts Australia, catering specifically to the Scouting and Guiding movements in North Queensland. All campers/visitors are expected to behave in a considerate and courteous manner and to ensure all campsites and facilities are kept clean. <p><b><u>Alcohol</u></b> Consumption to be restricted to your campsite area. Please refrain from consuming alcohol in the proximity of any youth (Scout/Guide/School) activities. Responsible consumption of alcohol is to be observed by all campers/visitors</p>	<p><b><u>Barrabadeen Camp power</u></b> Lights around the campsite will go on for two hours from sunset til around 8.30pm. Toilet led lights are on all night.</p> <p><b><u>Private generators</u></b> "Silent" inverter type only to be used onsite. Running time is between 9am and 10pm only</p>
<p><b><u>Amenities</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult while using amenities</li> <li>&gt; Mops/brooms are located in each block, please clean up after yourselves</li> <li>&gt; <b><u>Campsite toilets are composting type. Human waste and paper only</u></b></li> <li>&gt; Baby nappies, sanitary pads, cans, bottles etc do not compost, please use bins provided</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Behaviour</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; No noise after 10pm, please consider others <u>at all times</u></li> <li>&gt; Camp only on the site number allocated to you. Make sure your camp/vehicle does not encroach onto your neighbour's site.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Private chemical toilets (porta potties etc)</u></b> Not to be emptied into any toilets on site. Dump point is located at Tablelands Regional Council's Sewerage works, Grove St Atherton (open 9am-4pm weekdays).</p>
<p><b><u>Check out time is 10am.</u></b> However, in consultation with the Caretaker, you are welcome to stay for the remainder of the day if the site is not required for a following booking.</p>	<p><b><u>Day Pass</u></b> is available for day use only and those not staying overnight. Fees apply. Please pay the Caretaker on your arrival.</p>
<p><b><u>Dogs – NO DOGS ALLOWED</u></b></p>	<p><b><u>Speed limit: 10 km/hr (walking pace)</u></b> <b><u>No unregistered vehicles. No dirt bikes or quads.</u></b></p>
<p><b><u>Rubbish &amp; Recycling</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; All general rubbish to be bagged and placed in <b>green lid</b> wheelie bins.</li> <li>&gt; Recycle bins <b>yellow lids</b>: cans, glass, cardboard, steel and plastic bottles only and no plastic bags. No Cling film, ceramics, food scraps or household waste</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Boating</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Canoes and powerboats to keep clear of flagged swimming area and must be a minimum 30 mtrs from shore and/or swimmers and canoes</li> <li>&gt; Canoes and sailboats have right of way at all times</li> <li>&gt; No skiing adjacent to camp sites, respect other users</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Foreshore</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; No fires or tents below tree line except sun shelter for day use</li> <li>&gt; No parking below tree line</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Emergency</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Please report immediately to Caretaker</li> <li>&gt; Any incident involving injury to campers/visitors must be reported asap to the Caretaker and an incident form completed with full details of person(s) involved.</li> <li>&gt; Telephone is available at <b>Caretakers office 4091 4387</b></li> <li>&gt; <b>Dial 000 – location address is RN116 Danbullia Rd, Tinaroo via Atherton Qld 4883</b></li> <li>&gt; In an emergency, please assemble at the <b><u>EVACUATION ASSEMBLY POINT</u></b> in the main car park behind Caretaker's house.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Bunk Beds – Dormitory/Bunk house</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Only persons 9 years of age or older may utilise the top bunk</li> <li>&gt; No playing on top bunks</li> <li>&gt; All Joey Scouts and Cub Scouts are prohibited from using the top bunks</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Flora and fauna-NO DOGS ALLOWED</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Wildlife (do not feed) – we have Wallabies, Bettongs, Possums, Goannas, Snakes and many species of birds on site. They are all protected.</li> <li>&gt; All living/standing timber is protected. Do not chop any living/standing tree, small or large.</li> <li>&gt; Restitution for any damage to trees will be applicable</li> <li>&gt; Stakes protecting young trees are NOT to be removed</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Fires</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Gas cookers are permitted – gas bottles are not available on site. Nearest refills available at Tinaroo Caravan Park</li> <li>&gt; <b><u>GROUND FIRES ARE NOT PERMITTED.</u></b> Please use fire drums provided. Extinguish all fires with water.</li> <li>&gt; If available, ground deadwood on campsite areas may be used as firewood for cooking fires. Please BYO tools for cutting firewood and also wood for larger campfires.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>The Point</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Is the area south of the bunkhouse/dormitories</li> <li>&gt; No camping permitted in this area – Exception – self contained motor homes that utilise their own shower and toilet – this is at the discretion of the Caretaker.</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>Low Ropes Activity area</u></b> – located behind the shelter at The Point is out of bounds to ALL campers. To be used only by prior arrangement, with authorised/qualified supervision.</p>	<p><b><u>Firearms</u></b> – not permitted anywhere on Camp Barrabadeen</p> <p><b><u>Trail bikes</u></b> – not permitted anywhere on Barrabadeen</p>
